## Clinical Excellence

**Surgeon lead from each specialty**: Trained robotics surgeon who represents the needs and thoughts of each contributing service line

**FT Robotics Coordinator**: A dedicated, full-time coordinator for the robotic survery service line

**Dedicated robotics team**: CST, RN, CFA, etc. – fully invested, aligned, and well-trained clinical support team dedicated to the robotic surgery service line

## Operational Excellence

Perioperative Services

**Dedicated Data Analyst**: Hospital liaison who helps capture, organize, and communicate programmatic data for evidence-based strategy

**Service Line Steering Committee**: Meets quarterly, at a minimum

**Anesthesia, M.D. Lead**: A representative from the department of Anesthesia who supports the robotic surgery service line

**SPD Sponsor**: Reprocessing or Materials Manager who is invested and contributes to the robotic surgery service line
